Excepting the purchase of a road registered vehicle, where we are legally bound to pass your name, address and date of birth details to DVLA, you are under no statutory or contractual requirement or obligation to provide us with your personal information; however we require at least the information above in order for us to deal with you as a prospect or customer in an efficient and effective manner.

The legal basis for processing your data is based either on your specific consent, compliance with a legal obligation or our legitimate interest that we will have requested or stated at the point the information was initially provided, therefore we will not store, process or transfer your data outside the parties detailed above unless we have an appropriate lawful reason to do so. Unless we are precluded from doing so by law, you have the right to remove your consent at any time to the processing of your data by contacting us and requesting that processing of your details be restricted or deleted.
